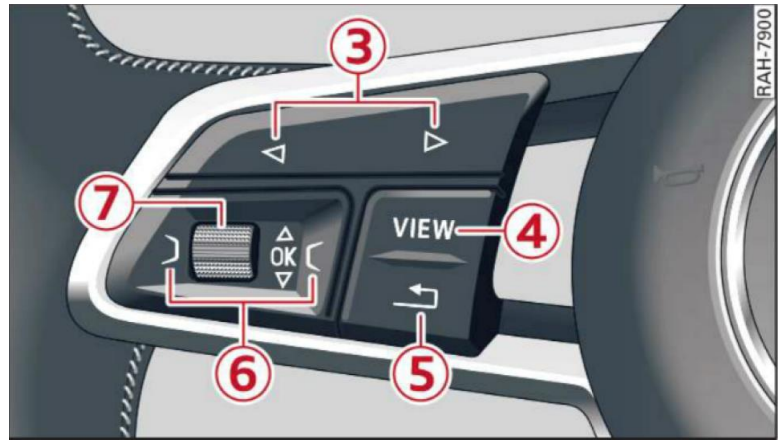


Virtual cockpit left steering wheel controls

- ③ TAB BUTTONS
- ④ VIEW BUTTON
- ⑤ RETURN BUTTON
- ⑥ CONTROL BUTTONS
- ⑦ LEFT THUMBWHEEL



1.0 Tab buttons ③

- 1.1 1st tab, onboard computer
 - 1.1.1 Time and date
 - 1.1.2 Average fuel consumption
 - 1.1.3 Short-term memory summary
 - 1.1.4 Long-term memory summary
 - 1.1.5 Energy consumers
 - 1.1.6 Driver assistance (if so equipped)
 - 1.1.7 Traffic sign recognition (if so equipped)
- 1.2 2nd tab, driver messages (only visible when warning light or message is present)
- 1.3 3rd tab, radio/media
 - 1.3.1 Left control button for selection menu
 - 1.3.2 Right control button for more options
- 1.4 4th tab, telephone (some functions for factory phone only)
 - 1.4.1 Left control button for selection menu
 - 1.4.2 Press left thumbwheel to answer a call
 - 1.4.3 Select and confirm “End call” to hang up
 - 1.4.4 Similar functions on right steering wheel controls
- 1.5 5th tab, navigation (depends on vehicle)
 - 1.5.1 Left control button displays maps, selects destinations, etc.
 - 1.5.2 Right control button for map colors, orientation, zoom options

2.0 View button ④

- 2.1 Standard view: large speedo and tach, smaller central data
- 2.2 Expanded view: small speed and tach, larger central data
- 2.3 Sport view: large central tach, small data left/right (if so equipped)

3.0 Return button ⑤

- 3.1 Return to previous function level

4.0 Control buttons ⑥

- 4.1 Left control button, open/close selection menu
 - 4.1.1 Example: radio band
- 4.2 Right control button, open/close options menu
 - 4.2.1 Can add “Additional display” inside speedo or top left

5.0 Left thumbwheel ⑦

- 5.1 Scroll to find a menu/list item
- 5.2 Press to select or confirm a menu/list item
- 5.3 Scroll to zoom in/out on a map
